Skills for Care initiated

Skills for Care approaches an organisation from their quality assurance visits or from the NQAP moderation to explore if the organisation would like to make an endorsement application in relation to an identified example of their practice.

A panel member/Skills for Care lead will contact the ASYE co-ordinator for the organisation and arrange a meeting with them. To reduce the impact on capacity, the meeting will be held virtually, unless both parties decide that a face-to-face meeting would be more appropriate.
